02. **Instructions for participation:**

- The participants will write a letter to Bangabandhu expressing their three wishes for Bangladesh. The letter has to be hand-written;
- The participants will recite any part of the historic 7th of March Speech within the specified time limit for each group;
- The winners will be invited to read out their letters live and the winning videos will be displayed during the virtual event;
- All participants will receive certificate of participation and the winners will receive prizes and certificates. All certificates and prizes will be sent by mail/post.
- The decision of the jury is final.
